



**Disability Advocacy Day at the State House  
March 3, 2010**

**NEW PARKING INFORMATION**

- **130 bagged meters** will be available for free all-day parking. Please **see the map in the brochure** - locations of bagged meters are shown on the map with dotted lines. Parking passes are NOT required for bagged meters on the street, but you can use one if you like.
- **The Public Parking Garage** located on the corner of Pendleton and Park streets, one block from the Blatt Building where registration is held, is convenient. Guides at the entrance of this garage and at the public garage on Lady St. (both shown on the map in brochure) will give you an all-day parking pass for the dash of your vehicle as you enter the garage, if you don't have one with you. The parking pass IS required for free all-day parking in garages. (Park St.-8 ft. clearance; Lady St.-6 ft. 5 in.)
- **Entrance to Blatt Building:** The sidewalk in front of the Blatt Building on Pendleton St. is open for foot traffic. The entrance to the Blatt Building on the Pendleton St. side of the building is locked. Enter the building on the other side, facing the State House. You can go up the steps on the Pendleton St. side and walk around to the other side, or go to the ramp next to the building (near traffic light) and go to the other side of Blatt Building to enter.
- **Parking and drop-off is not allowed in front of the Blatt Building and Brown Building** on Pendleton St. The sidewalk is open for foot traffic. There will be **no drop-off of passengers at the ramps** between these two buildings. The ramps are open to walk to the Blatt Building on the left of the ramps and the State House grounds.
- **There is only one accessible ramp for drop-off of passengers, located on Sumter St.,** beside the State House. Guides provided by Babcock Center will assist with unloading, give directions and give free all-day parking passes.
- **Traffic guides** provided by the City of Columbia and Babcock Center will be posted at corners to give directions and parking passes. They will be holding signs to identify them.
- **A copy of the Parking Pass** is attached. Parking passes also can be emailed - please request from DADay Cosponsors, DDSN Boards and Service Providers. ***Parking passes are required ONLY in the garages, where they will be given to vehicles as they enter, if you don't already have one. Parking passes are NOT required at bagged meters or the State Parking Lot.*** Parking passes can be used at bagged meters if you like.

**NO DROP-OFF OR PARKING IN CAPITOL COMPLEX UNDERGROUND GARAGE FOR ANY REASON.**
